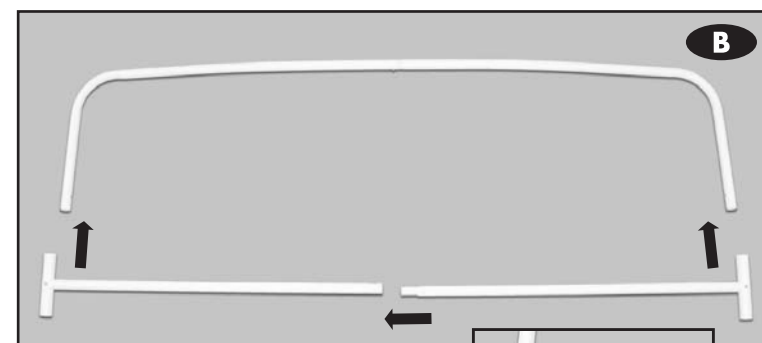
SET UP:

To Assemble Fabric Panels:

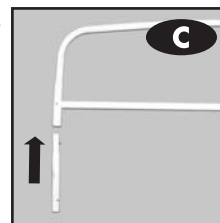
1 Take two top rails and slide the male top rail into the female top rail, until they lock into place (see Figure A).



2 Take two center rails and slide the male center rail into the female center rail, until they lock into place (see Figure B). Slide the center rail assembly with the four holes facing down until it locks in place with the top rail assembly.



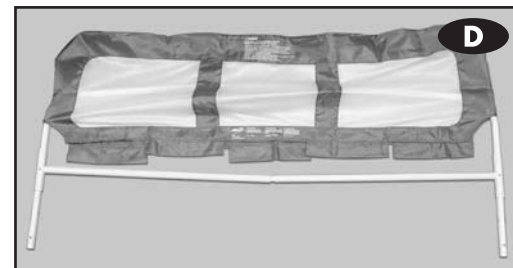
3 Orient one of the connector tubes so that the smaller diameter end is facing toward the top rail opening. Push the connector tube into the end of the top rail until the spring-loaded button snaps into the hole of the top rail (see Figure C). Repeat for other end of rail assembly.



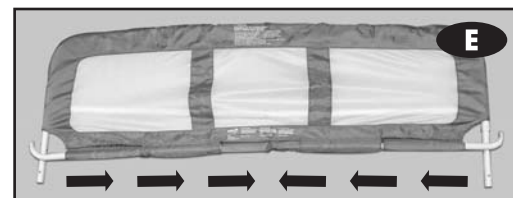
NOTE: If connector tube spring-loaded button does not snap into rail, twist rail until the sound of spring-loaded button snap is heard.

4 Slide the rail assembly into and between the two sides of the fabric cover (see Figure D).

NOTE: Make sure the Summer Infant logo on the fabric cover is on the opposite side of the spring-loaded buttons in the center rail ends.

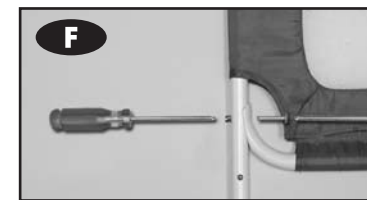


5 Starting at opposite ends of the fabric cover, take a male and female bottom rail and slide into all pockets until they lock into each other in the middle (see Figure E).



SET UP (continued):

6 Align through-hole on bottom rail with through-hole on connector tube, and attach post and screw using two screwdrivers (see Figure F).



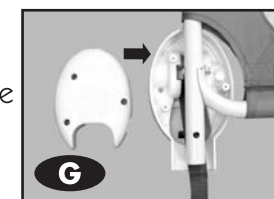
NOTE: Make sure the fabric cover is tight and the nut is on the inside. Secure both ends of the fabric cover assembly with the hook and loop tabs.

Repeat entire process for the other end of the same fabric cover assembly.

To Assemble Foot & Latch Mechanism:

7 Take fabric cover assembly and place it onto a flat surface with the Summer Infant logo facing down.

8 Locate the left foot and latch mechanism (letter L in-molded inside mechanism housing). Position the inside of the mechanism up against the fabric panel assembly, making sure all tubes nest into the grooves (see Figure G).



NOTE: The foot is still loose at this time and is attached only by the web strap. Take the left backplate (also marked inside with an L) and place over tubing. Mate the front and back halves until they fit together.

9 Screw in three screws through the back plate (see Figure H).



CAUTION: Do not overtighten the screws.

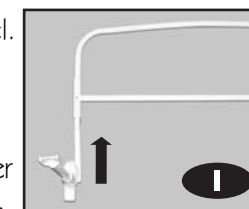
10 Push the attached support foot onto the bottom of the connector tube until the spring loaded button snaps into the hole (see Figure H).

Repeat steps 7 - 10 for the other end of this same fabric cover assembly.

To Assemble Folding Mechanism:

11 Repeat steps 1 & 2 for other panel.

12 Assemble folding mechanism as shown in Figure I.

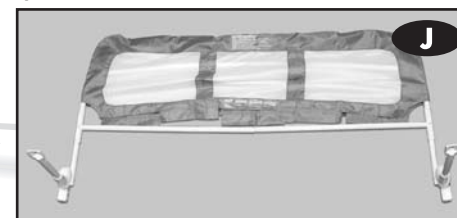


NOTE: Blue folding mechanism release lever should be facing out as shown in Figure I.

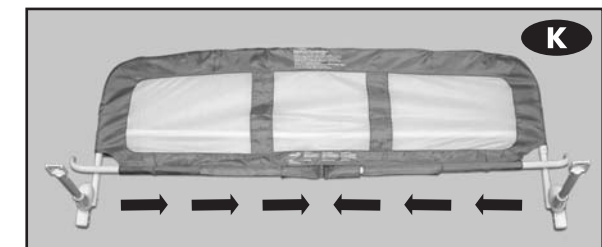
Repeat step 12 for the other end of this same fabric cover assembly.

13 Slide the rail assembly into and between the two sides of the fabric cover. See Figure J.

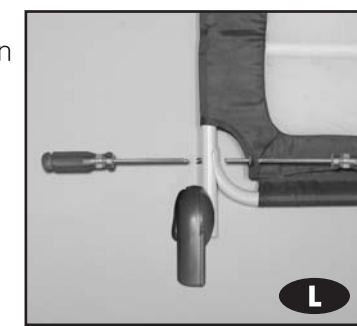
NOTE: Make sure the Summer Infant logo on the fabric cover is on the opposite side of the spring-loaded buttons in the center rail ends.



14 Starting at opposite ends of the fabric cover, take a male and female bottom rail and slide into the pocket until they lock into each other in the middle. See Figure K.



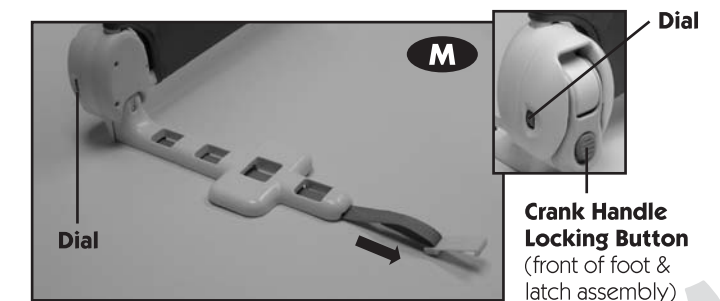
15 Align through-hole on bottom rail with through-hole on folding mechanism, and attach post and screw using two screwdrivers (See Figure L).



To Assemble Bedrail onto Bed:

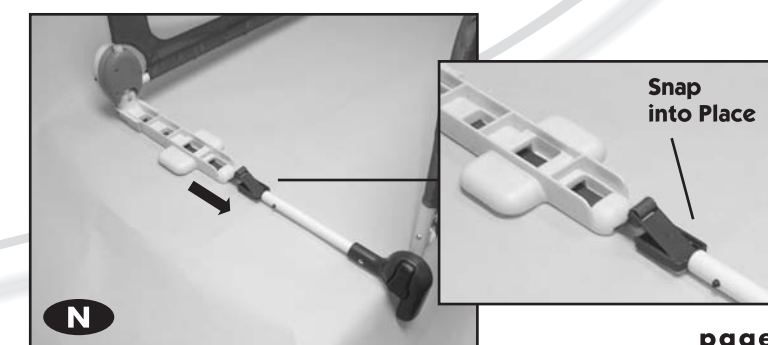
16 Remove the mattress from the bed.

17 Position one fabric cover/bedrail assembly on each side of the box spring with the support feet facing each other.



18 Pull out the strap by turning the dial on the side of the mechanism up and sliding the crank handle locking button down (see Figure M). NOTE: This assembly step may be easier with the assistance of a second person.

19 Take the clip at the end of the foot & latch assembly strap, and strap onto the end of the folding mechanism. Snap tab into place (see Figure N). Repeat on other side.



SET UP (continued):

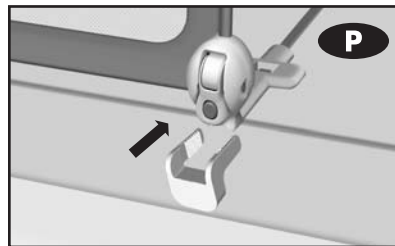
To Assemble Bedrail onto Bed (continued):

20 To use crank handle mechanism, slide the crank handle locking button down and pivot up the crank handle. Using the crank mechanism at each end of the bedrails, place a slight amount of tension on the straps while the two bedrails are positioned at the edges of the box spring (see Figure O). DO NOT tighten fully at this time. NOTE: If necessary to release tension on the web strap, unlock the crank handle, turn dial on side of mechanism up and slide the crank handle locking button down. If the crank handle is pushed down all the way, it will lock back into place. It will be necessary to unlock the crank handle again. NOTE: At this time, perform a final check on all screws and parts to ensure proper installation.



21 Place the mattress back on the bed.

22 Insure that the bedrails are centered on the mattress end to end with AT LEAST 9 inches of opening between the headboard and footboard and the end of the bedrails. Using the crank mechanism, tighten the straps until the bedrails are tight against BOTH sides of the mattress. **CAUTION: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN. DO NOT DEFORM MATTRESS.**

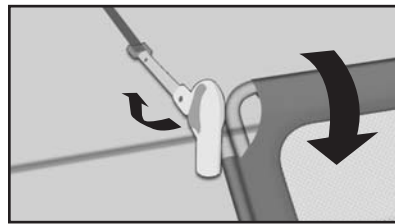


23 Press fit box spring clamp until tight against box spring (See Figure P). Repeat on other end of this same fabric cover assembly.

NOTE: At this time, perform a final check on all screws and parts to ensure proper installation.

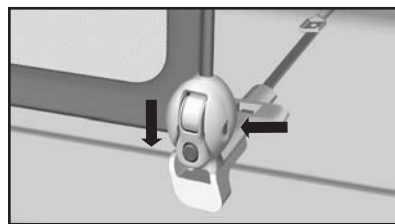
TO FOLD DOWN BEDRAIL:

To fold bedrail down pivot handle out: start to fold down bedrail, repeat on other end and complete the folding process.

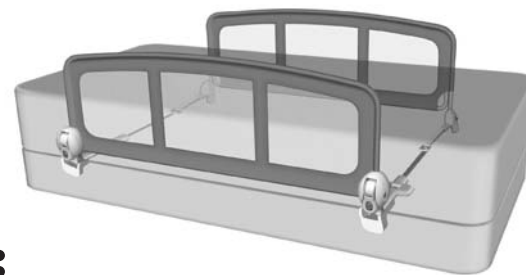


TO LOOSEN BEDRAIL FOR REMOVAL:

Turn dial on the side of the foot & latch mechanisms and slide the crank handle locking button down to loosen the fabric webbing.



FULLY ASSEMBLED VIEW:



NOTE: Measure mattress thickness and adjust center rail, using spring-loaded clips on each side, to fall approximately 1" below mattress surface.

NOTE: Periodically check the bedrail for tightness and ensuring the crank handles are locked in place.

TO CLEAN:

To clean the Sure and Secure™ Double Bedrail, surface wash with damp sponge, mild soap and cold water. Rinse and lay flat to dry. Do not remove fabric cover from frame.

Thank you for buying the Sure and Secure™ Double Bedrail from Summer Infant. It's the only two-sided bedrail on the market, providing toddlers with extra security at bedtime. This double bedrail is easy to install and provides parents with a high degree of confidence knowing their child is less likely to roll out of bed.

WARNING

- Suffocation and Strangulation Hazard.
- Death or Serious Injury Can Occur:
- Bedrail can trap young children against mattress, headboard, or footboard.
- Use only for children who have outgrown a crib. NEVER use in place of crib.
- Use only with children who can get in and out of adult bed without help.
- ALWAYS keep bedrail pushed firmly against mattress and at least 9 inches from headboard and footboard.
- NEVER use on toddler bed, bunkbed, waterbed, or bed with inflatable mattress. Use only on adult bed with mattress and box spring.
- Discontinue use if damaged, broken or if parts are missing.

NOTE: Periodically check the bedrail for tightness and to ensure the crank handles are locked in place.
