INSTRUCTION MANUAL

SURE AND SECURE™ SINGLE BEDRAIL

Thank you for buying the Sure and Secure Single Bedrail from Summer Infant. This single bedrail is easy to install and comes fully assembled out of the box. The single bedrail provides parents with the comfort of knowing their child is less likely to roll out of bed.

! WARNING:

- This bedguard is suitable for children from 18 months to 5 years only, and should only be used when child is able to climb in and out of bed unaided.
- Suitable for mattresses up to 30 cm thick.
- Never use without fixings firmly attached to the mattress.
- To prevent risk of strangulation it is essential to ensure that when bedguard is fitted into position, there is a gap of at least 250 mm (10") between each end of the bed and the bedguard.
- Do not use on beds higher than 60cm.
- Not suitable for use for the elderly or infirm.
- Use only for children who have outgrown a cot. NEVER use in place of a cot as it cannot provide the same level of safety.
- Periodically check the bedguard for general condition and for the security of the locking devices and hinges.
- NEVER use on toddler bed, bunkbed, waterbed, or bed with inflatable mattress. Use only on adult bed with mattress and box spring.
- Discontinue use if damaged, broken or if parts are missing.

NOTE: Periodically check the bedrail straps for tightness to ensure bedrail is snug against bed and fitted securely into place. Only use approved replacement parts, available direct from the manufacturer.

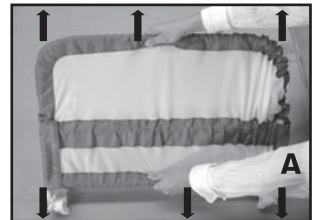

SET UP:

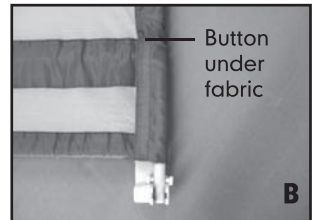
Step 1:

Expand bedrail height by holding the center of the top and bottom rails and expanding. See Figure A.



Step 2:

Grab far right end of top rail and bottom rail and complete expansion until you hear button click. Repeat for opposite end. **NOTE: Verify that the button is properly engaged by feeling on top of center rail as shown in Figure B on both sides.**



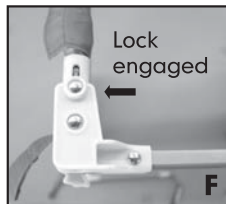
Step 3:

Expand bedrail lengthwise by holding left and right ends of bedrail and pulling outward (see Figure C) until you hear a button click. **NOTE: Verify that the buttons are properly engaged by feeling under the center of the top rail and the center of the bottom rail as shown in Figure D.**

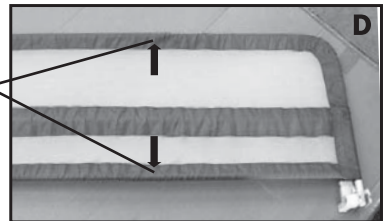


Step 4:

Fold down support legs as shown in Figure E, until spring lock is engaged (see Figure F).



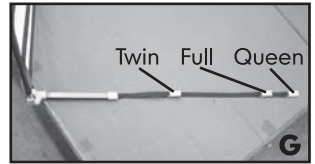
Buttons under fabric



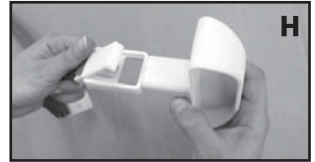
SET UP:

Step 5:

This bedrail fits twin, full and queen size mattresses (mattresses up to 30 cm thick, and between 173 cm and 214 cm long). Determine which size mattress you have (the bedrail is pre-set for twin mattresses) and connect mattress anchors to corresponding strap clip (see Figure G) on both sides by snapping mattress anchor into place. See Figure H.



NOTE: Be sure to orient the mattress anchor as shown in Figure I with notch facing down.

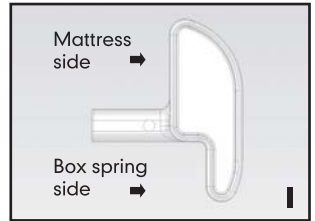


Step 6:

Remove mattress from bed.

Step 7:

Position assembled bedrail on box spring, making sure mattress anchors are on the outside of the box spring. See Figure J.



Step 8:

Place mattress back on box spring. See Figure K.



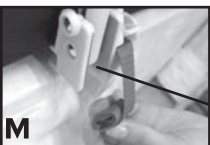
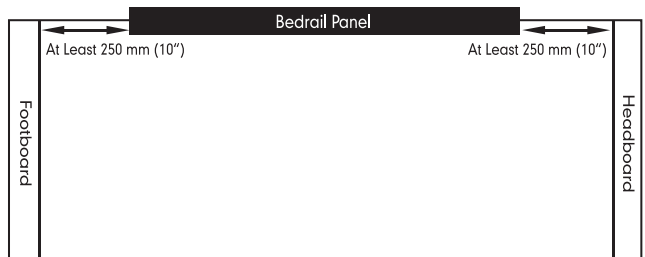
Step 9:

Ensure the bedrail is centered on the mattress end to end. Using enclosed template, measure AT LEAST 250 mm (10") between the ends of the bedrail and the headboard and footboard. See diagram below. While holding the bottom corner of the bedrail, pull the strap to proper tension until tight against the mattress. See Figure L. Repeat on the other end of the bedrail. Roll up excess strap and tuck under mattress. See Figure M.



Step 10:

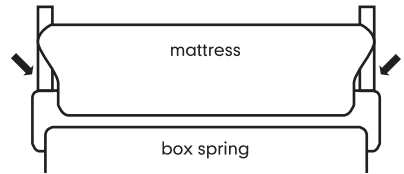
Once fitted in place, the bedguard should be checked to ensure that it is properly fitted and secure.

SET UP:

IMPORTANT NOTE: To Ensure against entrapment hazards, make sure there are no gaps between the bedrail and the mattress. Slight deformation of the mattress is acceptable. See diagram at right.



TO FOLD DOWN BEDRAIL:

Raise lock pins up on one side of bedrail support leg front and start to fold down bedrail, repeat on the other end and complete the folding process. See Figure N.



TO LOOSEN BEDRAIL FOR REMOVAL:

Push strap lock lever up on foot while pulling bedrail away from mattress. Repeat on other end.

CAUTION: Do not push strap lock lever down.



TO CLEAN:

To clean this Sure and Secure Single Bedrail, surface wash with damp sponge, mild soap and cold water. Rinse and lay flat to dry. Do not remove fabric cover from frame.
