Button function Guide

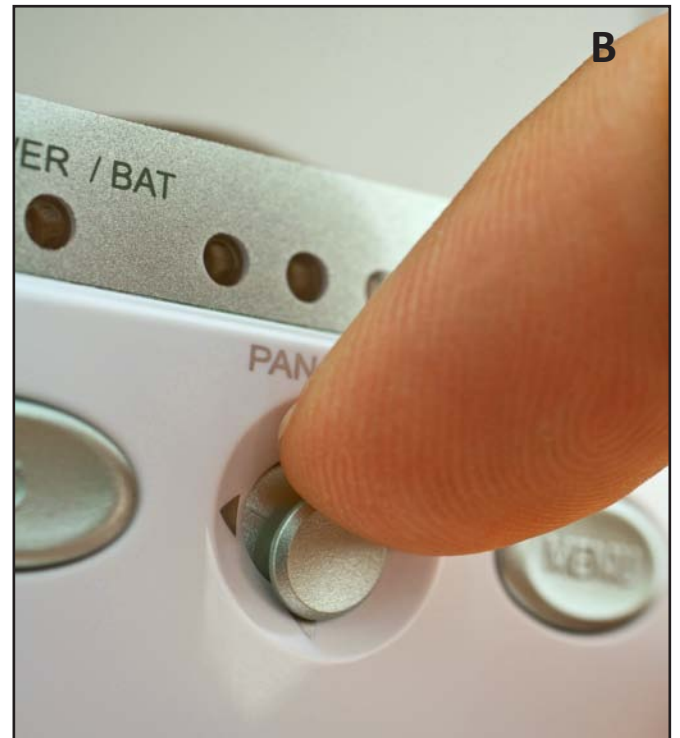
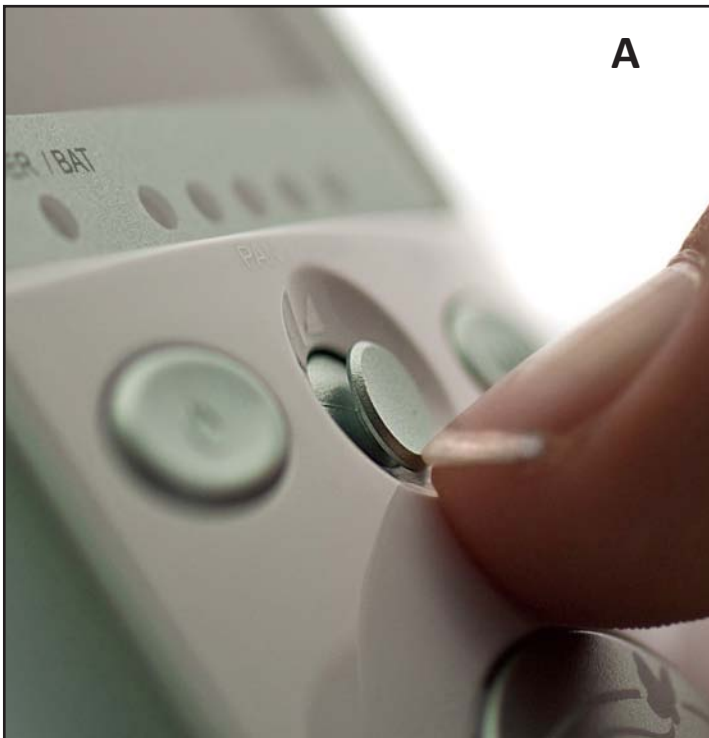
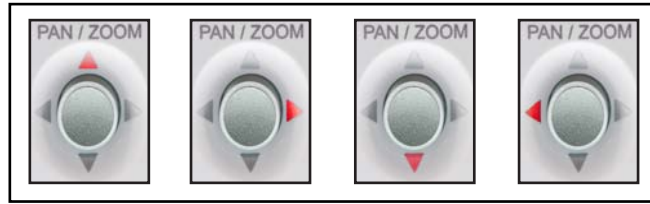

To use the toggle switch to pan the camera or whilst navigating the monitors menu, you need to pull the toggle switch in the direction you require.



Picture 'A' shows pulling the toggle switch to the down position using your thumb.

Picture 'B' shows pulling the toggle switch to the down position using your index finger.

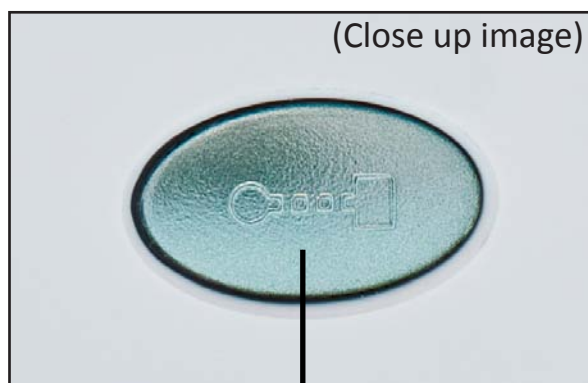
Please note that you are not required to push in the toggle switch during panning in any direction.

To zoom in press in the Pan / Zoom toggle button once. To zoom out, press it once again :

Camera Pairing Button

Adding and Pairing an additional Camera

Step 1

Turn on the monitor by holding down the (Power On / Off) button for 2 seconds :



Press the Menu Button on the Monitor once :



You will then see the screen below :



Whatever is highlighted in red can be changed.

Note the volume 'VOL' is highlighted in red showing that the volume can be adjusted.

Step 2

Scroll down using the Pan / Zoom toggle switch :



You will need to pull the toggle switch down three times until the 'ADD / DEL CAM' is highlighted in red. (Do not push in the central button)

You will then see the screen below :



Press in the Pan / Zoom button once :



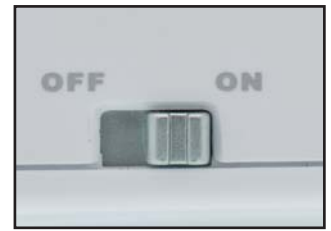
You will then see the screen below :



Step 4

Please ensure that the camera and monitor are next to each other and no further apart than 1 meter.

Ensure the camera you are going to pair is switched on :



You will need to action 'step 5' within 5 seconds of pressing the camera button in 'step 4' so please read ahead.

Press the pairing button on the rear of the camera :
(The button is located at the rear of the camera base next of the ariel)



Step 5

Press in the Pan / Zoom Button on the monitor within 5 seconds of pressing the camera button:

If you attempt to action this step before pressing the camera pairing button, the screen may freeze. If this happens wait ten seconds and start again from step 4.



After a few seconds your second camera will be paired and you will see a screen like this :



(Each time a camera is successfully paired it will show in blue on the screen above. The screen above shows that two cameras are paired because **DEL CAM#1** and **DEL CAM#2** are highlighted in blue).

Press the menu button twice to exit the main menu :

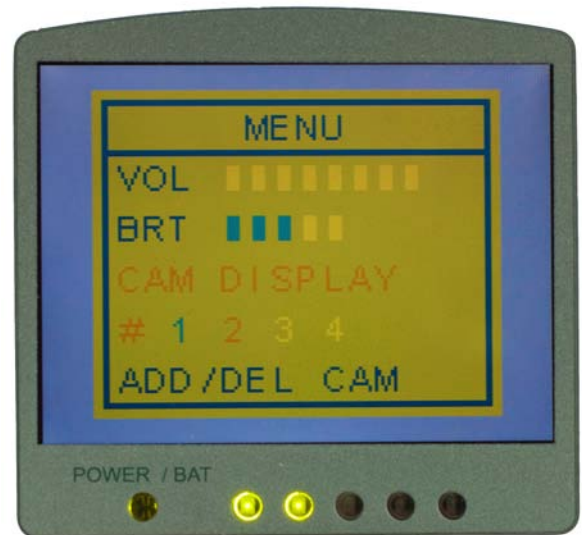


Step 7

If more than one camera is used you need to manually switch between cameras. You can change which camera you want to view by pressing 'MENU' and using the toggle switch to scroll down to 'Cam Display'. You will automatically be on camera #1 as shown in picture A. To view camera #2, use the toggle switch to move to the right as shown in picture B.

Press the 'MENU' button again to exit the menu and start viewing your selected camera.

You can now enjoy panning and zooming on both cameras
